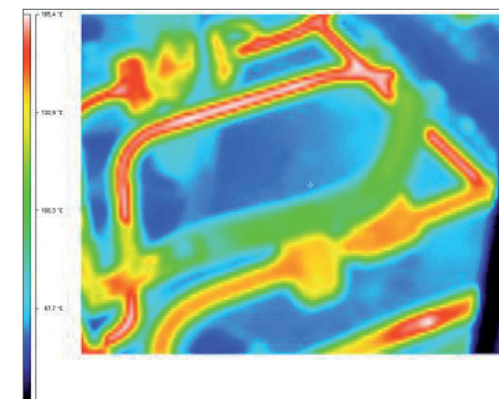


Who can participate?
